



The Knowledge Hub was created as a **backbone** organization to **connect** and **bolster** the combined impacts of projects with shared goals.

From 2022 to 2026, it facilitated a Community of Practice with projects working in the field of trauma- and violence-informed family violence prevention.

PRIMARY KNOWLEDGE HUB ACTIVITIES



- Implementation Coordinators who worked as relational anchors
- Quarterly online Community of Practice meetings to connect, share updates, discuss collective impact, and plan future activities
- Quarterly online bulletins with news updates about the Knowledge Hub and Community of Practice projects
- Bilingual events (English- and French-first with translation)
- Annual in-person Community of Practice “Knowledge Exchange” meetings
- Working groups focused on particular sub-themes or issues, such as sustainability
- Webinar series with external speakers to share knowledge on family violence research and practice
- Discussions touching on both research and practice issues (including presentations by external experts)



- Written and other resources to support Community of Practice members and widely share co-created knowledge
 - Website to publicly profile Community of Practice projects
 - Webinar series to share Community of Practice project activities and results with a large audience
 - Social media to connect with Community of Practice members and share their work with wider audiences
- Culminating national conference to share Community of Practice project outcomes with national audience
